


### **Lily Comfort Dog**

### Lily Comfort Dog



The Anchor of Hope Alliance aligns and equips universities, rescue missions, and local communities to address opioid addiction.

This grant would provide:

\$1,500 for a laptop; \$700 for 2 Anchor of Hope structures;

\$800 for transportation and administration.

A future goal is to build a Christian trade school on Holy Faith property

to provide meaningful jobs.











### **New Shepherds for South Sudan**
