The Anchor of Hope Alliance aligns and equips universities, rescue missions, and local communities to address opioid addiction.

\$1,500 for a laptop; \$700 for 2 Anchor of Hope structures; \$800 for transportation and administration.

A future goal is to build a Christian trade school on Holy Faith property to provide meaningful jobs.

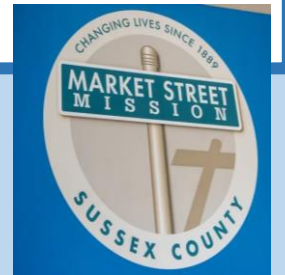
DID YOU KNOW that along with MSM in Morristown, we also have Mission locations in Asbury Park & Newton, NJ?

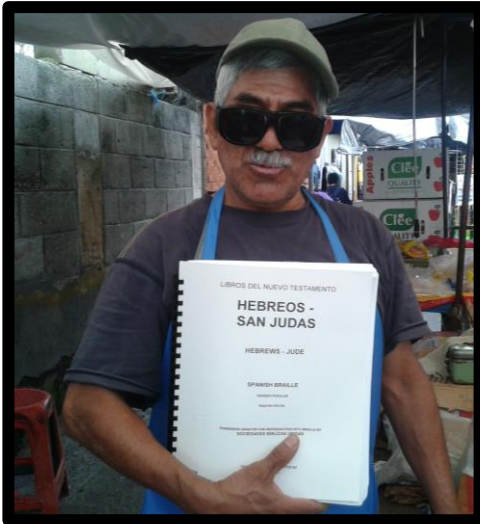

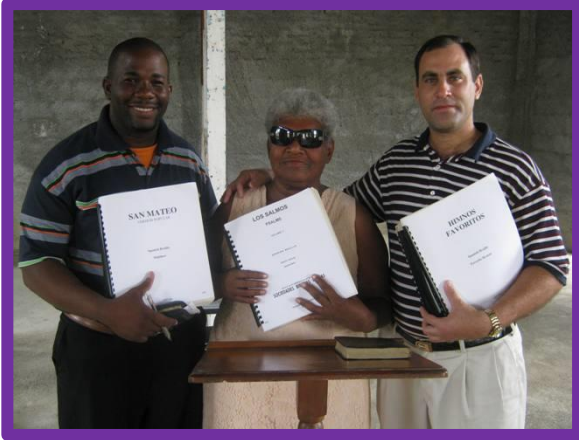

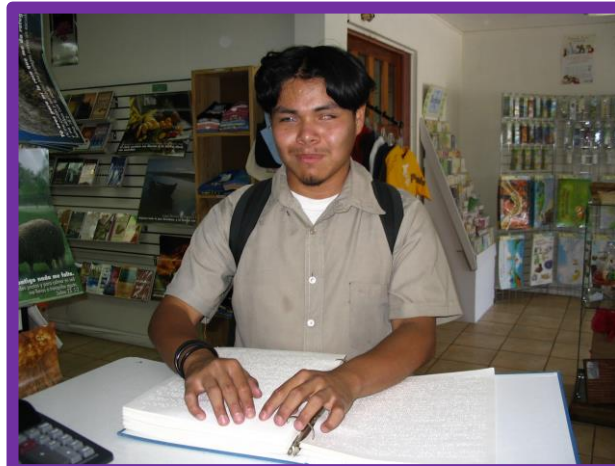
Lutheran Braille Workers Spanish Bibles to Central and South America

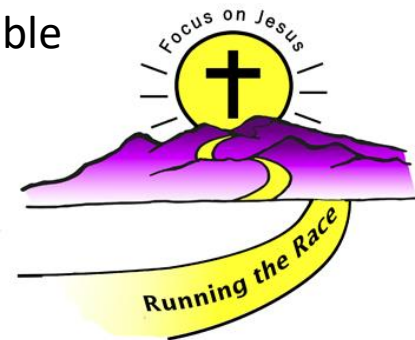
